V. President's Report (Jason Heller)

- A. School Board Report:
 - Of course, the big news is that our Superintendent, Dr. Holodick has submitted his resignation as he has accepted a position at the University of Delaware starting February 1st. This past Monday night, the Board appointed Asst. Superintendent Lincoln Holer as Interim Superintendent during the search for a permanent replacement.
 - 2. At the October 21st board meeting an RFP was approved for an in-school Behavior Support classroom at P.S. DuPont. This is an extension of the pilot program that was started at BHS last year.
 - There was Board Planning Retreat held on November 4th focused on a data review and update on academic progress from PK-12th grade, as well as an update on safety & security initiatives as well as discussion on potential impacts of the Redding Commission
 - 4. At Monday's board meeting (November 18th) in addition to the appointment of an Interim Superintendent, Board Policy 4.5, which addresses the use of social media and communication, was updated to better define parental permission and the Family Education Rights & Privacy Act. In addition, Dr. Hale presented the first read of the final FY2020 operating budget of \$205.5 million.

VII. Member Comments on Agenda Items or General Springer Topics

- (please respect the time of all members by keeping comments brief) a. Kids can have their own home access accounts to see what grades are missing. Not all teachers use schoology. Per Dr Woodson, schoology and home access do not talk to each other like they should. Frustrating for both parents and teachers. Parents see zeros or missing assignments when the grade just isn't entered yet. Per Mr Oberly - schoology is a good resource and you can do a lot with it, but it is still in a transition period. Some teachers use Schoology as a resource not as a grading tool. Hopefully as it progresses, more teachers will be using schoology. Springer is ahead of most middle schools using schoology, but
- still having difficulties with the two systems communicating.
 b. Bathroom policy only policy is not in the first 10 or last 10 minutes of class. Parent stated that 2 teachers have a policy that if the class is before lunch that they cannot have a bathroom pass. All kids are encouraged to drink water throughout the day and each teacher should allow kids to use the bathroom if they are not abusing it.
