Subject:	SFA Financial Error / Audit

Board Members -

I wanted to alert you to a financial error in our SFA account as soon as I researched it fully. I audit our cash balances weekly, and last week noticed a charge on our SFA Debit card for \$23.79 to Amazon on March 25th. After a good amount of research (and significant time on hold with the bank) I learned that the charge originated from <u>MY</u> debit card! After further research (and time on hold...) with Amazon, I learned that unexplainably my family's recurring item subscriptions (that have been on our personal Amazon card for years) inexplicably switched to the SFA card. I have used this card to make purchases on my Amazon account for SFA related items such as hot dog boats, and mini-grant items such as the library podium most recently. It had never been used for personal purchases! Amazon has 'opened a ticket' to look into how that card was used for these items – they agree that my personal Amazon card is set as the default card on my account and that the SFA card should never have been charged for a recurring subscription.

In response, I did immediately cancel all other items in that subscription delivery service and removed the card from my account. I did learn that there was one additional item that had already shipped and was also charged to the SFA card for \$16.72. This totals \$40.51 that was improperly charged to the SFA card for my personal purchases. In light of this, I am, of course, immediately writing a check to the SFA for reimbursement.

In the interest of full transparency (especially because fiscal responsibility is a HUGE thing for me), I have asked Jason Hale to perform an audit of the SFA books from the start of the organization through March 31, 2019, and provide a report to the board of any concerns he has and suggested corrective action. I am leaving it up to him to perform the audit on his own or to form a small committee – whichever he prefers. (He is performing this audit in his role as a parent and SFA member – not as a BSD official). I believe this is the best, and most appropriate way to be completely transparent in this instance. I will also provide this same information to the membership at the next meeting.

Pleshette – Jason will be reaching out to get copies of the books, checkbook, receipts, etc. for his audit. I imagine he will also want to meet with you and me at some point as well.

Please let me know if you have any questions at all – I'd be happy to answer. I look forward to hearing Jason Hale's thoughts!
